

Bartlett Papers

There are approximately ten thousand receipts, bills-of-sale and letters from the Bartlett Papers that have been cataloged and scanned in the Society's internal database. These documents are searchable by individual names and general terms. This collection spans from 1740-1800 and consists of both professional and personal papers. The professional papers (approx. 75%) deal with Bartlett's role as naval agent under General Washington; outfitting and repair of vessels; and the purchase of supplies. Personal papers include correspondence between family members and friends and receipts from schools and organizations that he was affiliated with, including Harvard College and the Marine Society at Salem.
