




CABOT HOUSE RENOVATION

Collections Preservation and Accessibility Upgrades

To ensure that the Cabot House can continue to both maintain and preserve our historic collections and guarantee safety and comfort for all visitors, the museum’s board has voted to undertake a capital campaign to pay for the installation of a new HVAC system. This one-time upgrade will:


- prevent damage to the collections resulting from heat and humidity and preserve our historic artifacts for future generations
- make the building safer and more comfortable for visitors and staff
- allow the museum to hold programs year round




Exterior Site Plan: ● New exterior wood stairs and an accessible ramp with handrails.
